Forestry –

County Forestry Report—

Mr. Peterson reported that nine sales were active in June. There is approximately \$4.96M in sold-uncut timber on file at the time of the report. The County is currently in oak wilt restriction through July 15. Bids were received and reviewed for three ATV/UTV trail rehab projects; the cost and shortage of gravel is affecting project costs.

DNR Report—Mr. Fischer reported on June DNR activity and reminded people not to prune or cause injury to any oak trees until after July 15 to prevent oak wilt- contact Mr. Fischer to report oak wilt symptoms. Honeysuckle and garlic mustard are invasive species increasing in area forests; Mr. Fischer noted that native black locust has become prevalent in some areas of disturbed soil.

USFS Report—No report

Recreational Trails Report—Ms. Schroeder reported that grading is complete on Tuscobia and Moose Lake trails; Seeley Hills trails are next.

Zoning/Conservation Department – Mr. Kozlowski reported that conservation staff have assisted individuals with site visits for native plant restoration projects and are busy with permits, project designs and meetings with lake associations. Water samples were taken from Loretta and Barber Lakes for a grant project. Conservation provided public education on aquatic invasive species, is planning a LWFRFC guided tour, and is working with DNR on livestock siting and CAFO operations.
