Call to Order –Chair Ron Buckholtz called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm. Roll Call taken. Quorum was met.

Public Comment – Request made to speak during agenda item 14c.

Minutes from Previous Meeting – A motion was made by Mr. Peters to approve the minutes of the December 2, 2021, meeting; second by Mr. Schleeter. Motion carried without negative vote.

Municode Codification Update – Mr. Hoff presented the link to the draft of our ordinance in Municode. All department heads have been asked to review their respective ordinances prior to approval at the January 13, 2022, County Board meeting.

Circuit Court Report – Mr. Hoff advised that the courthouse remodel is nearing the end of the planning phase and bids should start coming back next month for the remainder of the project.

Clerk of Court Report – Written report provided.

District Attorney's Office Report

Sheriff's Department Report – Sheriff Mrotek advised that the joint grant with LCO was approved by the State. The body scanner is in place and providing service as expected; it has prevented five cases of drugs being brought into the jail thus far.

A written communications report was provided. Chief Sajdera reported that another full-time dispatcher is leaving our employment and interviews begin next week. A written patrol report was provided. Lt. Ripczinski reported that call volume was down in December and is the same as this point last year. A written Communication Systems Specialist Report was provided. Ms. Shelton advised that she received in-house training from the Sheriff's department. Her written report was provided. A written jail report was provided.

Coroner's report --

Emergency Management Department Reports – EMS Director/Ambulance Director Nate Dunston advised that going forward this report will be combined with the Ambulance Service report. The ambulance service is still short four full-time EMTs and paramedic service is currently full. They are planning support for the Birkie in February.

Criminal Justice Coordinating Council Update – The TAD planning grant was approved. JusticePoint will be putting a plan in place and expanding services to staff three days a week at the LCO Tribal office.

- Patrol calls volume increased from last month's report for Jan' 22 at 725, the three-month trend shows Oct '21 was 762, Nov '21 with 1022, while Dec'21 was 699. This month is a decrease from Jan '21, which was 879 calls for service.
- For January 2022, Sawyer County Deputies in this period have issued 18 Citations for traffic offenses, 2 written warning and 10 Non-Traffic Citations. Per Community Maps there have been 14 Total Crashes, 1 with Personal Injury, and 1 Fatalities in our County for this time period (final numbers reported to DOT for previous months reflect differently from past P/S Reports due to various time and date range of the report).
