Call to Order – Chair Ron Buckholtz called the meeting to order at 9:00 am. Roll Call taken. Quorum was met.

Certification of Compliance with the open meeting law was met.

Meeting Agenda

Public Comment – Linda Zillmer

Minutes from Previous Meeting – A motion was made by Mr. Helwig to approve the minutes of the September 1, 2022, meeting; second by Mr. Savitski. Motion carried without negative vote.

Circuit Court Report – Courthouse Remodel Update – Mr. Albarado advised that there are no significant updates with project or budget.

Clerk of Court Report – A written report was provided.

District Attorney's Office Report

Sheriff's Department Report – Communication Center Report – A written report was provided. Chief Sajdera provided an update on staffing.

Patrol Report – A written report was provided. Lt. Ripczinski reported there was an increase in calls for service and the highlights of his report.

Jail Report – A written report was provided showing an average of 90 inmates last month.

Jail staffing and compensation – Mr. Albarado presented an overview of the staffing issues. There are many open shifts for the upcoming months. A short-term, temporary stipend is being considered to fill the open shifts as an incentive for existing staff to accept the open shifts. We are still recruiting for many positions; surveying 14 comparable counties we found that our starting wage is still a little under comparable counties. A motion was made by Mr. Buckholtz to approve the proposed staffing and compensation plan proposed by Mr. Albarado; second by Mr. Savitski and forward to the Finance Committee. Motion carried without negative vote.

Tribal Law Enforcement Grant – Mr. Albarado advised that we need to respond to the State that we want the grant for 2023 and that funds should go directly to the Tribe. This will return to the November meeting.

Communications Systems Specialist Report – Sheriff Mrotek reported the Simulcast system is up and running and in the process of being tweaked. Reception does seem improved throughout the County.

Code Enforcement Specialist – A written report was provided. Mr. Blicharz reported that he received full funding for a scholarship for the Animal Control I course. He advised that the license fees will increase from \$8 to \$10 for altered dogs and the daily kennel fee will be increased to \$20/day from \$10/day. He has begun working more with Zoning and Public Health code enforcement.

Child Support Department Report – A written report was provided.

Child Support MOU with DCF & LCO – Monica Chase, LCO attorney, reported on the MOU they have been editing the current MOU and plan to bring it back to the November meeting.

Coroner's report – A written report was provided. Mr. Froemel advised that he has some open investigations ongoing at this time.

Emergency Management Department Reports – Mr. Froemel reported that the department is doing a lot of training, as we are one of the most requested training sites in NW Wisconsin. There are currently no lapses in coverage. The grants that Mr. Dunstan had applied for have had a high award success rate. Some of those funds will be used for training.

2023 Budget Update – Written documentation was provided. Mr. Markgren highlighted the differences between requests and approved budget items. The budget includes two new Sheriff Department positions.

Criminal Justice Coordinating Council Update – Mr. Albarado advised the council is focused on the diversion court development. Our grant award could be up to \$300,000. The CJCC committee is expanding the membership to include Public Health staff.

Meeting Date/Time – The next meeting of the Public Safety Committee will be Thursday, November 3, at 9:00 am in the Assembly Room.

- Patrol calls volume did decrease from last month's report for Oct' 22 to **724**, the three-month trend shows July'22 was 989, Aug' 22 was 703 while Sept' 22 was 964. This month is a decrease from Oct '21, which was 762 calls for service.
- For Oct 2022, Sawyer County Deputies in this period have issued **38** Citations for traffic offenses, **1** written warning and **34** Non-Traffic Citations. Per Community Maps there have been **15** Total Crashes, **3** with Personal Injury, and **0** Fatalities in our County for this time period (final numbers reported to DOT for previous months may reflect differently from past P/S Reports due to various time and date range of the report).

CORONERS: Been busy with keeping up with Deaths Investigations and Cremations as well as keeping track of Hospice patient's in the county. We have been working on transitioning to a ME position and will continue to work with Andy as January gets closer. We continue to work with all the department's about traumatic event's that has happen through out the county. We also are continuing with training and working with my staff keeping them up on the latest death investigation techniques. To this date we are at 121 Death and Cremation Certifications this year.

Ambulance/Emergency Management Report: During this past spring and summer Sawyer County Ambulance put a strong push on educating Sawyer County residents on how to use of automatic external defibrillation or an AED. We are seeing more and more of these units pop up in the county and we want to make sure that our residents know how to use them. Businesses are becoming more proactive after finding out the value of these lifesaving units by purchasing them and hanging them on the wall of their business. In our training we also include familiarization in cardiopulmonary resuscitation or CPR. These sessions that we are putting on were just an introduction to what American Heart Association offers through Northland Technical College. American Heart association offers a certification upon completion of a full CPR class.

The Spider Lake church bought 3 AED's one for each of their three campuses. After sitting through our sessions they decided to certify several of their members in CPR through Northland College which one of our EMT's taught. We also had a couple of our EMT's participate in this class for continuing education credits which is mandatory for their license. We also had one of these sessions for the Nelson Lake Property Owners Association at the Hayward Armory where over 90 people attended. Nelson Lake has three Defibrillators located around their lake. We also have done sessions with the Hayward Methodist Church, First Lutheran Church and Treeland Resort. We have sessions also scheduled for Deer Foot Resort and the Grace Lutheran Church and the Sawyer County Library. We also want to set one up here at the Sawyer County Offices.

As you can see we are trying to get more people trained so we can have more bystander CPR performed on a patient if needed. This obviously will increase our out of hospital save rate in Sawyer County.

For EM we are finishing on the EMPG/EPCRA grant's. We are also going after a grant for reimbursement for training equipment through the Gary Sinise Foundation. I have attended the Regional EM meeting October 12, LEPC Meeting October 19th, as well as Fire Association the same day, I was also invited to the Town of Hunter Town Association meeting Oct 24 which I attended. In the first part of November I am enrolled in WEM Classes through the State of Wisconsin.

CORONERS: Been busy with keeping up with Deaths Investigations and Cremations as well as keeping track of Hospice patient's in the county. We have been working on transitioning to a ME position and will continue to work with Andy as January gets closer. We continue to work with all the department's about traumatic event's that has happen through out the county. We also are continuing with training and working with my staff keeping them up on the latest death investigation techniques. To this date we are at 121 Death and Cremation Certifications this year.

Ambulance/Emergency Management Report: During this past spring and summer Sawyer County Ambulance put a strong push on educating Sawyer County residents on how to use of automatic external defibrillation or an AED. We are seeing more and more of these units pop up in the county and we want to make sure that our residents know how to use them. Businesses are becoming more proactive after finding out the value of these lifesaving units by purchasing them and hanging them on the wall of their business. In our training we also include familiarization in cardiopulmonary resuscitation or CPR. These sessions that we are putting on were just an introduction to what American Heart Association offers through Northland Technical College. American Heart association offers a certification upon completion of a full CPR class.

The Spider Lake church bought 3 AED's one for each of their three campuses. After sitting through our sessions they decided to certify several of their members in CPR through Northland College which one of our EMT's taught. We also had a couple of our EMT's participate in this class for continuing education credits which is mandatory for their license. We also had one of these sessions for the Nelson Lake Property Owners Association at the Hayward Armory where over 90 people attended. Nelson Lake has three Defibrillators located around their lake. We also have done sessions with the Hayward Methodist Church, First Lutheran Church and Treeland Resort. We have sessions also scheduled for Deer Foot Resort and the Grace Lutheran Church and the Sawyer County Library. We also want to set one up here at the Sawyer County Offices.

This past month the Town of Spider Lake certified eleven of their residents in CPR/D-Fib. at their town hall. On the 6th of November they again will hold another CPR class at the Red Deer Resort and another to follow again at their town hall. The Town of Round Lake is working on setting up a class at their town Hall also. As you can see we are trying to get more people trained so we can have more bystander CPR performed on a patient if needed. This obviously will increase our out of hospital save rate in Sawyer County.

For EM we are finishing on the EMPG/EPCRA grant's. We are also going after a grant for reimbursement for training equipment through the Gary Sinise Foundation. I have attended the Regional EM meeting October 12, LEPC Meeting October 19th, as well as Fire Association the same day, I was also invited to the Town of Hunter Town Association meeting Oct 24 which I attended. In the first part of November I am enrolled in WEM Classes through the State of Wisconsin.

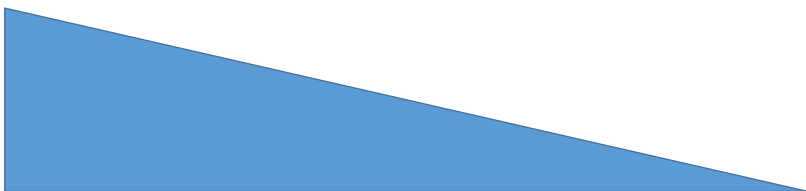
