Call to Order – Chair Jesse Boettcher called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.

Certification of Compliance with the open meeting law was met. Roll Call was taken; a quorum was met.

Meeting Agenda –

Public Comments – Susan Bauer

Minutes from the previous meeting – A motion was made by Mr. Helwig to approve the minutes of the December 7, 2022, second by Mr. Peters. Motion carried without negative vote.

Events – The following events were presented for consideration and approval: Seeley Hills Classic Ski Race (1/14), Seeley Big Fat Mountain Bike Event (1/21), Birkie Week Events (2/22, 2/24-25) and Fat Bike Birkie Week (3/11). A motion was made by Mr. Helwig; second by Mr. Peters to approve the list of events. A voice vote was taken and motion carried without negative vote.

Land Records and County Surveyor Department Report – Mr. Ploegger advised that snow conditions are hampering outside work. He presented a letter from the DNR requesting the lake to be named Bear Foot Lake. A motion was made by Mr. Peters to approve the name; second by Mr. Helwig. A voice vote was taken and passed without negative vote.

Sawyer County Forestry Department Report – Trails Report – Mr. Peterson advised the winter storm impacted every mile of recreational trail we have. Volunteer groups continue to work on clean up; he recognized the Snowmobile/ATV Alliance for all their hard work. They are working with neighboring counties to try to get funding for damages that totaled over \$130,000 on snowmobile trails and \$70,000 on Birkie trails. Ms. LaReau advised almost all of the lakes have been staked. Mr. Wright advised 35 of the 70-mile biking trail system is open. Their FB pages provide updates on conditions.

County Forestry Report – A written report was provided. Mr. Peterson provided an update on sales and revenues. Our YTD timber sale revenue was \$1,925,094 so we met target. Recon updates were over goal for the year. Mr. Peterson and Mr. Albarado had a conference call on the carbon credit project.

DNR Forestry Report – A written report was provided. Mr. Zubrod provided a snow trail closure update.

Approval of Emergency Fire Wardens – A list of emergency fire wardens was presented. A motion was made by Mr. Peters; second by Helwig to approve this list as presented and forward to county board. A voice vote was taken and passed without negative vote.

Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Grant motion to apply for funds for the recent purchase of the Cooper land was presented. A motion was made by Mr. Helwig; second by Mr. Peters to approve this resolution and forward to county board. A voice vote was taken and passed without negative vote.

Sawyer County Forest 2023 Annual Work Plan Approval – Mr. Peterson presented the outline for their plan of work for 2023 that allows them to apply for grant funds. They have several trail projects included. A motion was made by Mr. Helwig to approve the Sawyer County Forest 2023 Annual Work Plan and forward it to county board; second by Mr. Peters. A voice vote was taken and passed without negative vote.

2022-2023 Sawyer County Forest/WDNR Annual Partnership Meeting Minutes – A motion was made by Mr. Peters to forward the minutes of the 2022-2023 Sawyer County Forest/WDNR Annual Partnership Meeting to the county board for approval; second by Mr. Boettcher. A voice vote was taken and passed without negative vote.

DNR Update on CWD and deer baiting – Mr. Zubrod reported that out of all the samples submitted to date there have been no cases of CWD in Sawyer County.

Zoning/Conservation Department Report – A written conservation department report was provided. Mr. Kozlowski advised the tree sale is still up on the website with good pricing. The poster/speaking contest will be held on January 27th. The Price Dam gear mechanism repair is in process. We continue to be on an uptick on building permits. They are working on end-of-year cleanup process in reporting.

LCO Report – Mr. Bisonette advised that LCO departments served as emergency services areas during the winter storm. He thanked the local clubs that helped with trail cleanup. They have applied for grant funds through BIA for local conservation projects and draw-downs.

DNR Forestry Report for January 2023

Recreation (Kyle Marinoff, DNR Parks and Recreation Supervisor):

On the Flambeau River State Forest about 70% of ski trails are open and groomed. The other 30% is still a work in-progress to get open from damage caused by snow and ice received in December.

Ice conditions are still terrible, any use of travel other than foot is not recommended. Snowmobiles trails open on area lakes are doing the best but DNR is still getting reports of thin to no ice in spots (especially on the Chippewa Flowage) so again travel is not recommended. Some lake routes (on ice) throughout the county have not been completely marked due to unsafe ice conditions. There are trail segments that run across lakes that have either been somewhat marked where it is safe or not marked at all due to it being unsafe. - Tree sale is up and running and can be ordered through the County website. White Pine & Tamaracks are still available.
- Poster and Speaking Contest: 29 total posters across 4 age groups. 14 contestants for the speaking contest. Winners will represent Sawyer County at the area competition.
- Price Dam Update: Clutch/gear mechanism is in the process of being repaired. Hope to have finished in time for spring melt.
- Conservation staff is working on design projects for 2023. The majority of these projects are focused around shoreline stabilization.
- Submitting and applying for our 2024 Soil and Water Resource Management Grants.
- Lake Loretta/Upper Brunet River Dam Update: Gates are still being fabricated and hoping to time install of these gates with spring melt conditions in the March/April Timeframe. After gate and stop log install there will be some final site stabilization occurring in April/May. Water levels will continue to rise over this spring/summer timeframe. Restocking of fish to occur in Fall of 2023.
