Call to Order – Chair Ron Kinsley called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Certification of Compliance with the open meeting law was met. Roll Call was taken; quorum was met.

Meeting Agenda – #10 was moved to position #8 motion by Mr. Bisonette; second by Mr. Peters. Motion carried without negative vote.

Motion carried without negative vote.

Maintenance Department Report -

A written report was provided. The focus has been on work on the building project; much of the relocation work has been completed.

Sawyer County Airport Report -

A written report was provided. Mr. Albarado reviewed the highlights of the written report. Before the road bans went on the airport was able to bring in a full load of fuel. The terminal building is considered complete.

Updating Petition for Airport Improvement Projects – The State has not provided the packet yet so no action was taken on this item.

Hermel Hangar Lease – David Hermel – Mr. Albarado presented the Resolution and new lease for David Hermel. A motion was made by Mr. Helwig to approve the Resolution and lease; second by Mr. Peters. Motion carried without negative vote.

Highway Commissioner's Report -

A written report was provided and highlights were reviewed. Mr. Beise introduced the new Highway Commissioner, John Pinnow. Mr. Kinsley welcomed our new Highway Commissioner, John Pinnow, and thanked Mr. Beise for filling in. Mr. Beise reviewed the highlights of the report, including several county projects, one of which is trying to move up the CTH D bridge rehabilitation project.

ATV/UTV Ordinance Update – Mr. Kinsley asked Ms. LaReau to provide an update regarding a meeting held with LCO today. All routes were reviewed, and they discussed opening most sections of the routes except two. They seem to agree on a possible plan, and she is awaiting results from the Tribal Governing Board soon. Trails are scheduled to open May 1st so an answer prior to that is needed in order to provide sufficient notice to riders and possibly consider re-routes to any routes not re-opened. No action was taken; a special committee meeting will be held Tuesday, April 18th, at 5:00 pm.

Mr. Albarado provided an updated copy of the ATV/UTV ordinance included in the packet. Text in blue identifies the only changes made since the March meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Helwig to forward the most recent copy of the ordinance with the recommendations made tonight to the special committee meeting and then forward to full board; second by Mr. Peters. Motion carried without negative vote. A motion was made by Mr. Bisonette; second by Mr. Helwig to have the changes put in the ordinance in regard to the hours of operation amendment and the sections of roads to be broken down within tribal boundaries, that it will also be made available for the April 18th meeting, and to place this item on the full county board agenda. Motion carried without negative vote.

Courtroom Remodeling Update -

Mr. Albarado advised the AV contractor could not complete the work on the original planned schedule so this delays the move to the new building, thus the old courtroom must remain available through next week. We should be in the new courtroom April 24th. The judge and several staff have moved into their new spaces. The contingency fund is used up at this point.

Call to Order – Chair Ron Kinsley called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

Certification of Compliance with the open meeting law was met. Roll Call was taken; quorum was met.

Mr. Kinsley asked Cathy LaReau to provide an update of the meetings she has been having with members of the LCO tribe regarding ATV routes. Agreements have been reached to open most routes with an exception of a couple small segments on E and NN. This will provide access to all businesses previously impacted.

Highway ATV/UTV Route Request -

Sawyer County ATV/UTV Routes April 2023 – An updated route request list was provided for the packet and reviewed by Mr. Albarado. He shared segments that were not approved at the last meeting, additional temporary routes proposed on Cty Rd H and NN. The list identified other sections of Rd CC, E, K and S that would be re-opened per the sections identified in the handout agreed upon with the tribal representatives and Ms. LaReau who was representing the Alliance. Clarification on some of the segments was reviewed. A motion was made by Mr. Rusk to approve the routes excepting the three routes carved out in the presented list; second by Mr. Peters. Motion carried without negative comment.

ATV/UTV Ordinance Update – The draft in the packet is the most recent version that was presented in the last Public Works meeting. Mr. Albarado reviewed the edits that were recommended at the last Public Works meeting. The routes just approved would be added back to the ordinance. Any new requests would require an ordinance amendment that would need to go through Committee level. New route requests are recommended for May, August and October, with an annual renewal date of the ordinance being May of each year. A request was made to ask the County to pay for the installation of signs which would be purchased by the Alliance; Mr. Pinnow will review section 2.02 speed limit sections. A motion was made by Mr. Peters to move forward with the ordinance with the edits discussed and documented; second by Mr. Kinsley. Motion carries with one nay vote from Mr. Helwig.

Mr. Schlender requested that route requests be reviewed monthly due to potential changes in conditions; he requested this point to be made part of record and that riders respect the authority of policing officials.

Maintenance Report May 2023

Along with routine building and equipment maintenance, the following maintenance projects were started, continued or completed in April:

I. Courthouse:

- Our new maintenance technician has completed his EPA 608 technician certification. Completing the certification process allows him to assist us with HVAC repairs and installation for all of our properties.
- As a requirement of staying current with EPA 608 certification, Mick Bestland, Craig Steinborn and I will be attending an A2L refrigerant certification class in Duluth, MN on May 1, 2023. By 2025, A2L refrigerants will be required in all new air conditioning equipment sold in the United States.
- We have completed the cabinetry we were fabricating for the phase one of the courthouse addition project and hope to have it installed soon.
- With the exception of egress lighting, we recently converted all lighting in the Northwest Journey portion of the Oasis building to LEDs.
- I have completed the process of obtaining estimates for projects that will be potentially included in the 2024 CIP.

II. Highway:

- In April, we worked on some HVAC concerns at the Radisson shop and a couple of building issues in Hayward.

III. Sheriff:

- All of the Sheriff's Department fleet vehicles, that were ordered as part of the 2023 CIP, have been delivered and should be in service soon.

IV. Airport:

- In preparation for the upcoming mowing season, Jon Frank has agreed to return as our LTE at the airport. Jon has done a great job for us at the airport for several seasons now.

Sawyer County Airport Management Report

May 2023

(Provided by Airport Manager Derek Leslie)

- On Wednesday April 26th, Governor Tony Evers again flew into the airport. Its always a pleasure to have the GOV inside the terminal building.
- Aircraft operations have slightly increased, and are up year of year compared to last. FBO operations have also seen an increase.
- All motorized gates at the airport are functioning properly.
- We have two projects now on-going simultaneously. Our runway rehab is still sitting at 90% design as we wait for funding determinations from FAA and WI BOA. Current timeline is Spring 2025 Construction with a hope of Federal Supplemental funding to be awarded which would bump it up to 2024.
- The Master Plan PAC committee has been invited to the first of 4 meetings to be held on May 25th. We have had a great response from the individuals asked to be a part of this process. Among the various folks in the community and of the airport group, all three corporate operators that were asked will be aiding in the plan as well.
- Winter cleanup has begun, snow removal operations resulted in merely a few broken lights and turned up sod around the airfield. Considering the winter, I would say that Thompsons did a great job. Now we just need to fix some of the sod ahead of grass mowing season.
- This year with road bans shorter than usual we managed to NOT run out of fuel at the airport. Overall the airport is in great shape and we are ready for another busy tourism season.

Highway Commissioner's Report

I attended the April N.W. District Commissioners meeting in Polk County. I had the opportunity to meet the surrounding Commissioners. Next Commissioners meeting is set for May 25th in Bayfield.

Sawyer County road bans were removed May 1st at 12:01 p.m.

The crews have started stage 3 storm damage clean-up from the previous winter storms. We're currently at 67,262.11 in expenses of the 279,000 that was anticipated for the storm damage. Crews will continue to work throughout the summer to meet our deadline of August 31st. This deadline can be extended if needed.

We have crews continuing to fix signs, patch holes and crack seal. Still fighting potholes on several county trunk highways and there is a crew or two constantly out patching the roadways and fixing signs.

Update on the County C Bridge. We completed some patching on the deck and there has been some concerns. I reached out to Ayres to see if we could get this project moved up to this summer. Ayres said this is already an aggressive schedule and the earliest this project can start would be spring / summer of 2024. I also reached out to Corre (bridge Inspection) to see if they had any concerns with this bridge. Corre has no concerns at this time. We'll continue to monitor this bridge throughout the year.

County W south road project update. Monarch will be using Thompson's pit which is located 5 miles south of Ojibwa. This 5 mile road project will start August/September.

The Summer Road School (aka Highway Conference) will be held June 5-7, 2023 at the Chula Vista Resort in Wisconsin Dells, WI. This will be an in-person conference.

Registration for the conference must be made online before May 12, 2023. Any interested committee members should contact the highway department office for further details.

Interviews were conducted for a driver/operator position on April 25th, 2023 for the Winter shop. The position in the Winter shop has been filled. A driver/operator resigned his position in Hayward. There is currently a vacancy for a driver/operator position in the Hayward Shop. We also posted our seasonal ads for skilled laborers and flaggers.

We completed our MSHA training on May 3rd at the Hayward highway shop.

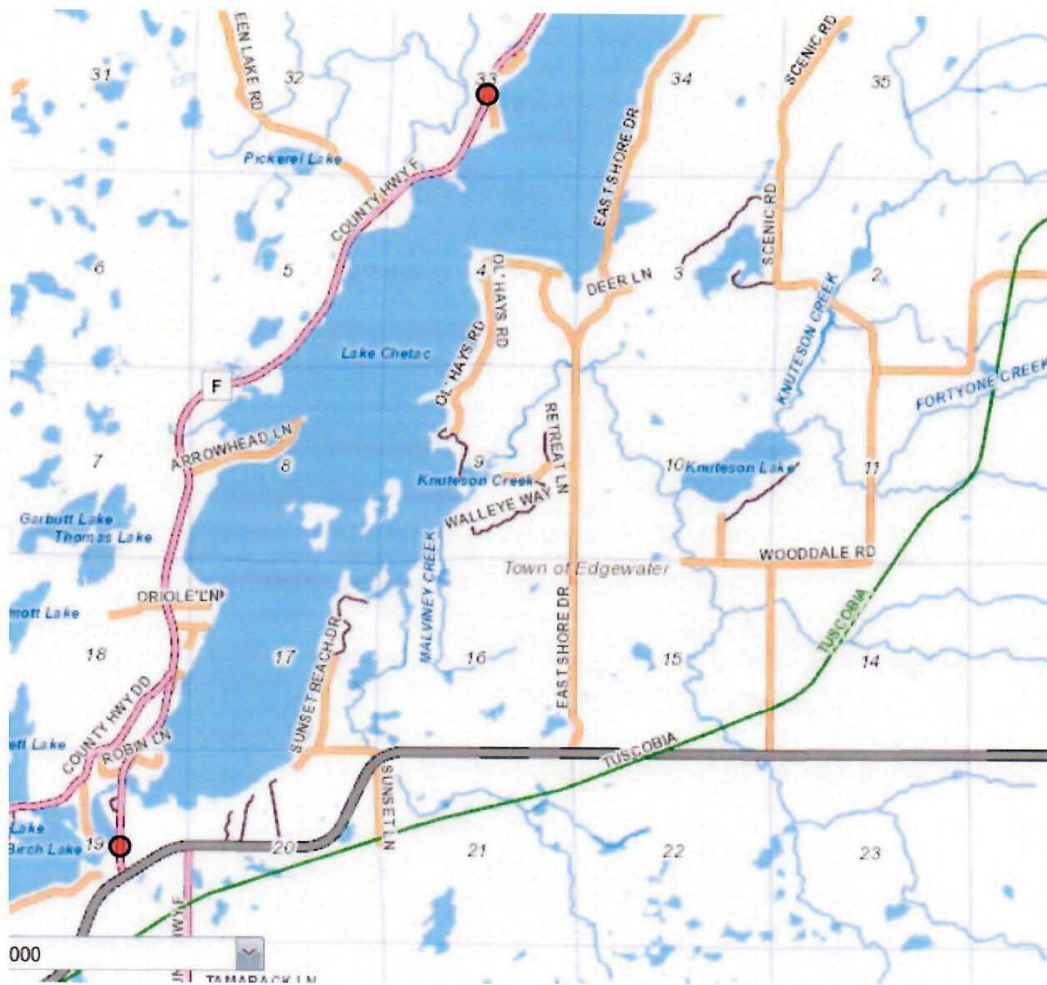

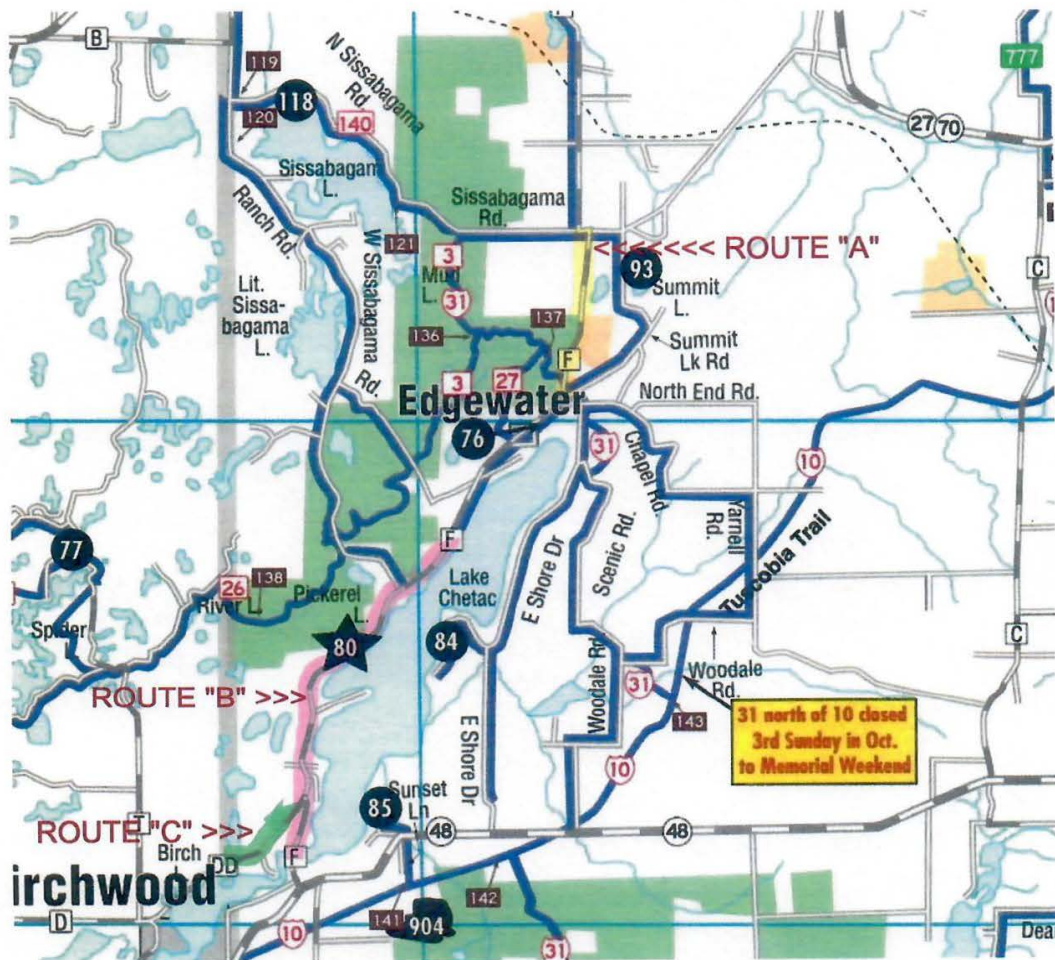
Red circles indicate start and end of requested route on County Road F.

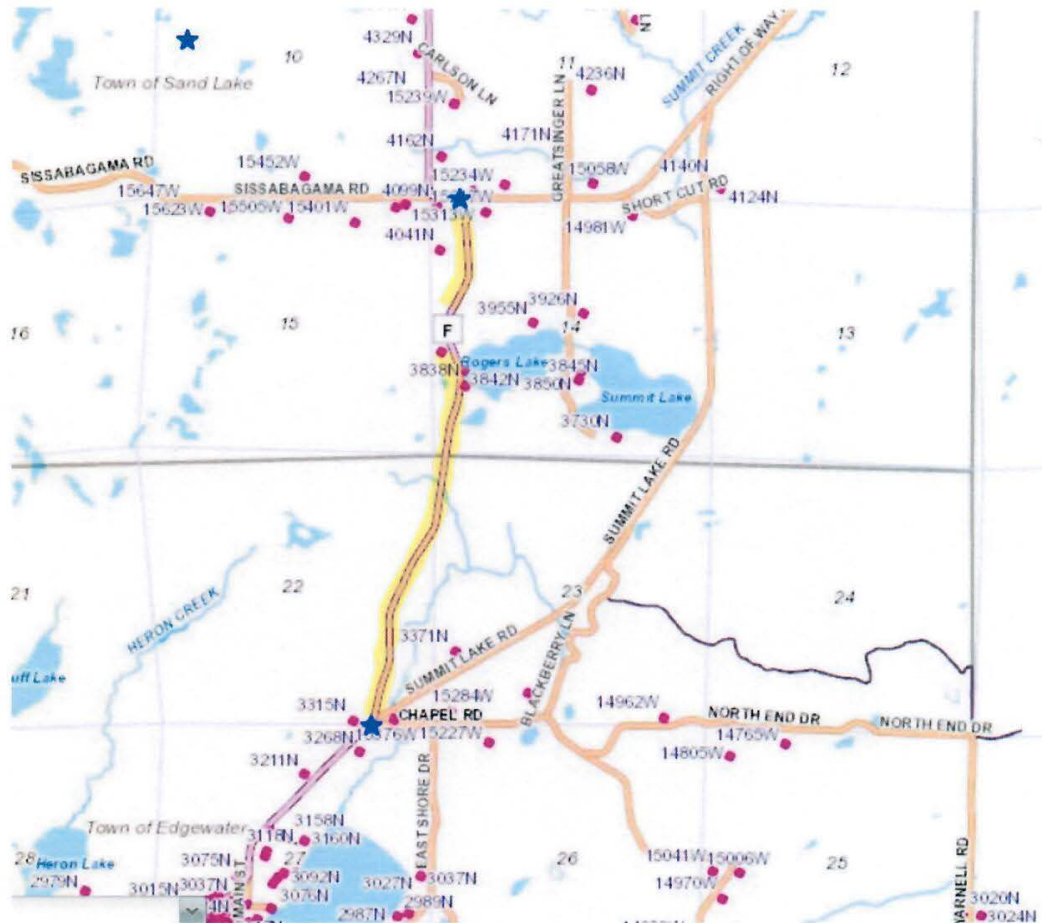

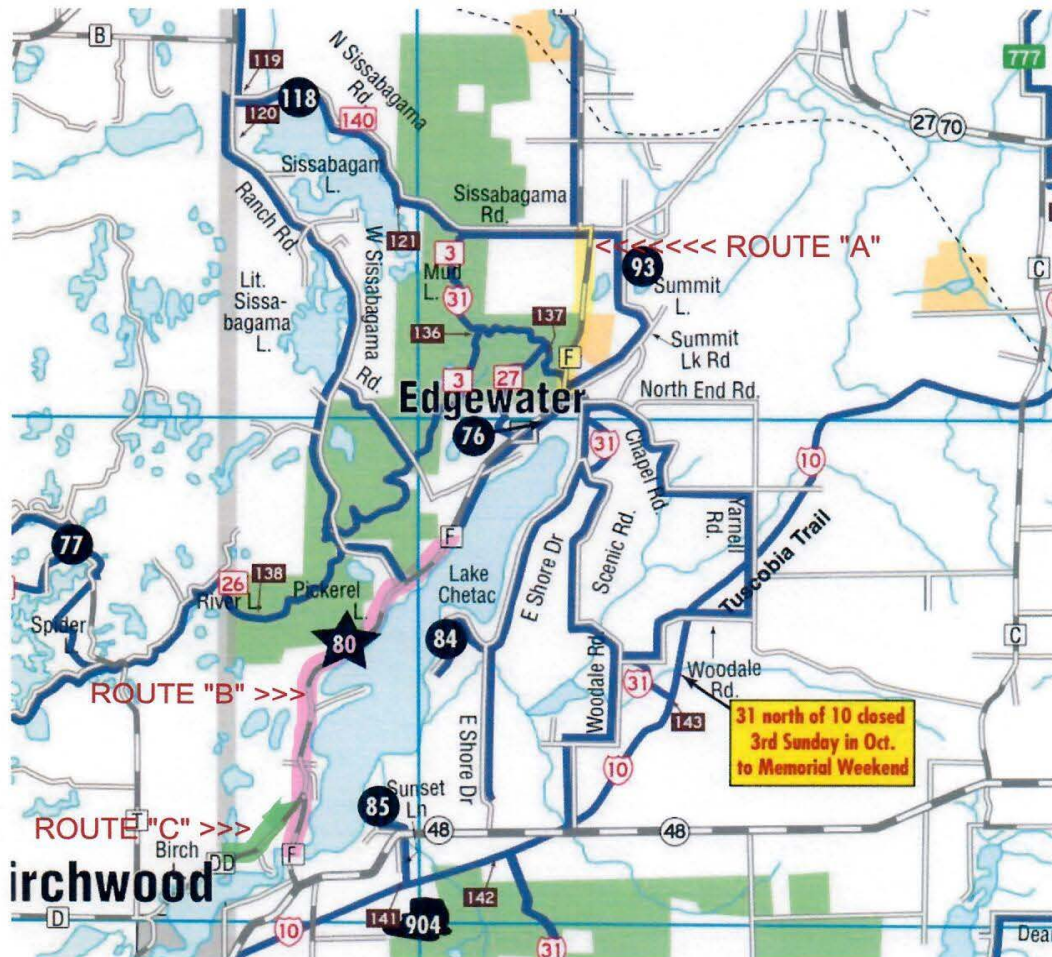
Proposed ATV Route on CTH F from Chapel Rd to Right of Way Rd April 2023

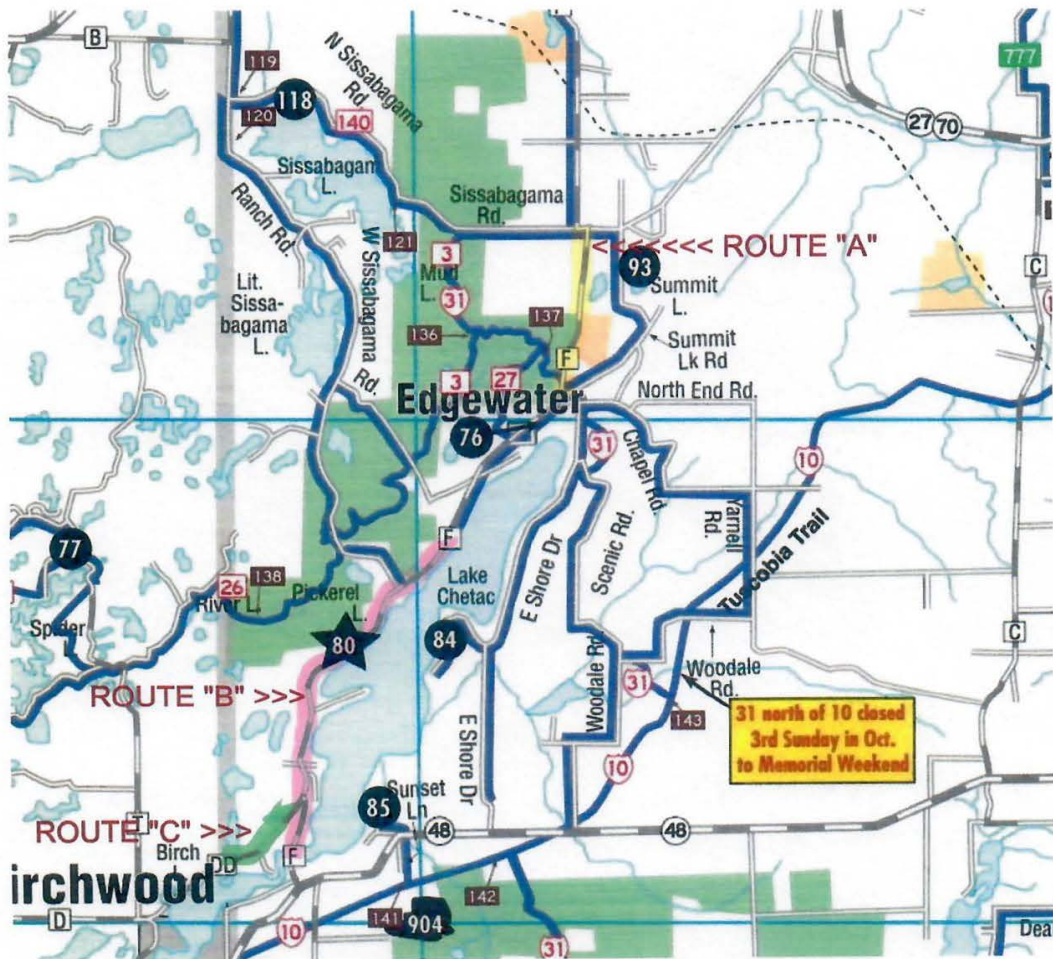
Proposed ATV Route on CTH DD – April 2023
