Call to Order – Chair Ed Peters called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.

Certification of Compliance with the open meeting law was met. Roll Call was taken; a quorum was met.

Register of Deeds Update -

A written report was provided detailing counter activity. The office ended 2023 with county share of transfer fees being at 181%, roughly 60,000 over budgeted amount. Register of Deed fees were at 104%, roughly 4,200 over revenue.

Events - None

Land Records and County Surveyor Department Report -

Surveyor's Report – A written report was provided detailing surveying activity; six certified survey maps were reviewed in December 2023.

Real Property Lister Report – A written report was provided. All tax bills have been printed and were distributed to municipalities by Friday, December 15th, and the tax roll copies were submitted to DOR. They are working with the assessors to make a smooth transition away from Personal Property using the new Building, Fixtures, and/or Improvements Document.

Sawyer County Forestry Department -

Recreational Trails Report – Ms. LaReau advised that the lakes are not yet completely frozen; they are working with LCO to add their ATV trails to their Alliance maintenance contract.

County Forestry – A written report was provided and reviewed by Mr. Peterson. They continued with a high level of timber sales and value of uncut/unfiled is \$4M+. There is a fair amount activity carrying over into 2024. Plots have been entered in the carbon tax credit project.

2024 County Forestry Department Annual Work Plan – A written report was provided to give direction and meaning to the proposed County Forest Comprehensive Land Use Plan and emphasizes the current needs of the County Forest

and Recreational System. A motion was made by Mr. Helwig; second by Ms. Wilson to approve this workplan and forward to County Board. Motion carried without negative vote. A copy of the 2023 Sawyer County Forest/WDNR Annual Partnership meeting minutes was included. A motion was made by Mr. Helwig to accept the Minutes of the Annual Partnership Meeting and forward to County Board; second by Mr. Peters. Motion carried without negative vote.

DNR Forestry – Mr. Fischer advised that they have been working in the harder-to-access areas of the forest.

Zoning/Conservation Department -

County Report – A written report was provided and reviewed. At next month's meeting they will be submitting a resolution to apply for the WI DNR Municipal Dam Grant for repairs/reconstruction to the Fishtrap Lake Dam; the AIS grant was accepted and approved by the DNR. They will begin updates on other Dam inspection, operation, and maintenance plans (IOMP's) and emergency action plans (EAP's).

Basic resource information is collected, stored and updated systematically and continuously. Database is used to analyze existing resources, evaluate management alternatives, and assist in the development and implementation of management plans.

Made and concluded this 13 day of SEPT. 1977, A. D. 1977, by and between JOHN DIETZ

and JAMES J. SCHMITT part Y of the first part,

Witnesseth, First, That the said part Y of the second part hereby agree S and bind S himself, and his legal representatives, to pay or cause to be paid, to the said part Y of the first part, his heirs, or assigns, the sum of Twenty-Seven Thousand (\$27,000) Dollars, in the manner following: Seven Thousand (\$7,000) Dollars, at the sealing and delivery hereof; the balance of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) is to be paid over a five (5) year period. Said payments of principal shall be as follows: Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to be paid on the 15th day of March, 1978, and a like amount to be paid every six (6) months thereafter until paid in full on September 15, 1982.

In addition to the above semi-annual payments, party of the second part shall pay interest on the unpaid principal at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum.

NELSON LAKE DRAWDOWN PROPOSAL – FALL/WINTER 2024-25

Proposed: Lower water levels in Nelson Lake by 4’ beginning in mid to late September 2024 and completed by mid to late October. Refill to be done by early April 2025.

On July 13, 2022 the Sawyer County Land, Water, and Forest Resource Committee approved a request to lower the water levels in Nelson Lake for the winter months of 2022-2023 as a part of a 10-year plan to positively impact walleye spawning.

In 2004, a fish management plan was presented and approved by the Nelson Lake Association. Walleyes were the emphasized species. Since then, numerous habitat projects and extended growth walleye stocking has been conducted with little or no apparent success. Finally, a 4’ drawdown (as suggested in the plan) was conducted in the fall-winter of 2020/2021 again with no apparent immediate success. Water level manipulation is the only factor related to walleye spawning (as it tends to create preferred habitat) that is uniquely available on flowage lakes. All other factors that impact successful spawning such as water temperatures, clarity, predation, aeration, and available forage are beyond human control and align infrequently. *The process for a new fish management plan will begin with a public hearing which was held February 6, 2024.*

In 2022, the Nelson Lake Association and the Nelson Lake Resort Association proposed that Nelson Lake water levels be drawn down to 2’ below normal water depth starting September 30, 2022 with the desired depth being reached on or before November 1, 2022. (The depth and timing of the drawdown was the result of a compromise with those who felt that a 4’ drawdown started earlier negatively impacted their use of the lake.) Refilling was to begin March 13, 2023 and be completed as quickly as possible (preferably before April 15, 2023). The primary goal of the proposed drawdown was again, an attempt to stimulate improved walleye spawning. We also proposed to have repeat drawdowns in 2024, 2026, 2028, and 2030 in hope of hitting a set of environmental circumstances that are favorable. The drawdown in the fall of 2022 was canceled due to paperwork and approval delays, but dry conditions lowered levels about 18” naturally.

The drawdown proposed for the fall of 2024 should be to 4’ to allow for the repair of the Nelson Lake Park boat landing which was damaged by repeated power loading. An additional pad is needed at the end of the ramp to prevent the formation of a scour hole. The placement and attachment to the existing pad can only be done above the water line and before freeze up.

The 10-year drawdown plan calls for an evaluation in 2026 of the impacts on apparent walleye numbers vs other fish species, vegetation changes, and physical issues related to changing water levels (such as stop log removal/installation), and make adjustments as needed.

DNR walleye stocking was ended in 2023. Instead NLA purchased 1200 extended growth walleyes from the St. Croix tribe which were stocked in October. Future plans include possible fingerling stocking in the summer of 2024.

Nelson Lake Drawdown Fact and Observation Sheet

- The discharge gate on the Nelson Lake Dam is 9' wide which will allow lake levels to be lowered at a rate of approximately 46 days per foot of stop log removed given normal inflows. (23 days if 2' are removed at once and so on.)
- Water level is based on the gage at the dam. 1.0 being the normal water level.
- An out-flow of 10 cfs is maintained to provide water to the river system below the dam.
- Freeze up can occur in early November.
- Refill of the lake was completed in 2021 on April 10th even though winter snow fall was low.
- The 2020 drawdown exposed extensive amounts of cobble and rock near shore which can be ideal walleye spawning habitat. 80 plus years of organic material was washed from these areas.
- Shallow water vegetation was not permanently impacted. There was some alteration of species and density in some areas. Water clarity was reduced due to increased staining.
- Most private docks and boat lifts are removed by early September.
- Some resorts and vacation rentals may have been impacted by the presence of lowered water levels. Boat launching was still available at the Gerlach Landing.
- Ice fishing was not negatively or positively impacted by the drawdown.
- Fall duck activity was increased.
- Fall surveys did not show any impact on walleye reproduction.
- Wild rice beds, which are minor on Nelson Lake, were not impacted by the 2020 drawdown and in some locations expanded.
- Some shoreline owners made illegal alterations to the lake bed in front of their properties. Others made permitted improvements to boat ramps.
- Loss of amphibians which over winter in shallow water are a concern of DNR biologists. A drawdown in September tends to avoid this issue because it allows them to locate before water levels drop. The 2020 drawdown which began September 16th and was completed November 1st had no apparent impact on amphibian numbers.
- Trapping may be impacted.
- Normal water depth at the end of the ramp was just under 4' in 2020 with rocks beyond that. Another 8' concrete plank is to be added to the end with additional large rock beyond.
